

## STBBI Screening and Prevention

The SIDEP des ITSS-Estrie is regionally mandated to provide prevention and screening services for sexually transmitted and bloodborne infections with the client groups identified in this folder.

## Client Groups

The client groups which are specifically targeted by SIDEP des ITSS services include:

- Drug users
- Street youth
- Sexually active gay or bisexual men
- Sex trade workers and their clients
- Persons who have sex with multiple partners
- Women who are victims of abuse
- Troubled youth
- Aboriginals
- Persons from endemic\* nations
- Inmates

\* Refers to a disease whose prevalence is practically permanent in a given area.

## Services

Services are provided at CLSC 50 Camirand Street and at other specified locations in Estrie.

- Advice, information, education and prevention;
- STBBI screening (sexually transmitted and bloodborne infections), including for HIV as well as hepatitis B and C;
- Vaccination against hepatitis A and B;
- Referrals to the appropriate resources when needed.
